

Request to Transfer Credit Taken at Another U.S. Law Program

Updated August 22, 2022

Students in the JD program may be approved to take courses from other ABA-accredited law programs in the U.S. and transfer up to 34 credit hours toward the University of Iowa JD. No credit may be transferred from non-ABA-accredited schools in the U.S., except as permitted by the Dean or Dean's designate and applicable to ABA standards.

All courses must be taken after matriculation in the University of Iowa JD program.

No more than 15 credit hours may be earned through distance education courses. This total includes any distance courses taken at the University of Iowa as well as at other law programs for transfer to the JD.

Students are strongly advised to seek advanced review and approval before enrolling at other institutions.

You are also required to discuss your attendance at another institution with the College of Law Financial Aid office if you receive financial aid.

Courses approved for credit transfer will show the final grade on the University of Iowa transcript, but will not be calculated as part of the University of Iowa gpa.
