POLICY ON MAKEUP EXAMS

Students with more than one exam on the same day, three exams on three consecutive days, or four exams on four consecutive days, may request to reschedule a final exam. The instructor's signature *is no longer required* for any of these instances. Rescheduled exams will be given on the next available makeup day after the regularly scheduled exam. The link to make this request is at <http://law.uiowa.edu/current-students> under Exam Information. The deadline for requesting makeup exams is **March 24, 2023**. Students will receive an email confirmation from Exam Coordinator Sark Clark once the request has been processed.

EMERGENCY AND ILLNESS

If before or during an exam a student believes that they cannot take or complete the exam because of illness, emergency, or personal tragedy, immediately contact Associate Dean Crain at 319-335-9648. An unexcused absence from an exam will result in a grade of 1.5. Any request for a makeup should include written verification of the event that caused the absence (e.g., doctor's note).
