Introduction to the Law of France I (1 s.h. credit)

The one-credit course will introduce students to the laws of France, their characteristic features, and the role of France's main institutions. The subjects will include the French Legal system, Civil law (Contracts and Torts), and Family law, among other subjects. As part of the course, we will visit Paris courts.

Taught by Michaël Amado, Adjunct Professor of Law, University of Paris; Avocat à la Cour, Amado-Cabinet D'Avocats, Paris, LL.M, MBA (University of Paris I Sorbonne). Professor Amado is Head Partner and Counsel (Avocat à la Cour) at Amado-Cabinet D'Avocats, which is a 50-year old firm engaged in the practice of Corporate law, Contracts, Labour law, and European law. Amado has taught with the Iowa study abroad program since 1998. He also currently teaches as an Adjunct Professor of Labour Law at the University of Paris Dauphine.
